Ages 6-9 Younger Children: We are all made in God's image and God is love. Take a photo where you see love. Use as your guide what St. Paul tells us in his letter to the Corinthians: Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. It does not dishonor others, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres. Love never fails.

Ages 10-12 Older Children: So God created man in His own image; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them. Genesis 1:27 Take a photo of someone who is living in the image of God. Explain why this person inspired you and how they live in God's image.

<u>Ages 13-17 Teenagers</u>: But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law. And those who are Christ's have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires. If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit. Galations5:22-25. The fruits of the spirit are tools to grow in Christ's image, take a photograph of one of the fruits of the spirit in action.
